AGM Monday, September 20, 2010 6.00 pm Minutes

- 1 Joe McColeman, President of NDMHL, welcomed everyone to the league's annual AGM.
- 2 Peter Michelutti gave a presentation on the Sudbury Silver Stick tournament
- 3 Joe McColeman introduced the NDMHL Board of Directors and convenors, NOHA Council Directors and NOHA Referee in Chief.
- 4 Minutes of the AGM May 5, 2010 were reviewed with a motion to accept by Ken Creasy, seconded by Cookie Campbell and carried.
- 5 Dave Laporte gave a financial report and asked that all monies owing be sent to his work address. Financial report motion to accept by Jim Hall, seconded by Carol Welch and carried
- 6 Joe reviewed the number of teams in each division and which association they were from.
- 7 League Business
 - a. Joe reminded the membership of the one constitutional change which was the additional vote for the association bringing it to a total of 8
 - b. This is the first year for the new competition structure and division alignment and Joe stressed to the membership that there would be growing pains and to show patience as we implement this new structure
 - c. Membership was reminded to refer to the league's website and that's it's a work in progress and comments and feedback is welcome
 - d. Convenors need to receive from each team tonight: ice time, practise slots, copy of team roster.
 - e. Blind River's Crystal Serre is the leagues Peewee Division 2 convenor.
 - f. League playoff tournament is March 24-27, 2011 for Novice, Atom, Peewee and the league is considering minor Bantam and will wait for feedback from the coaches and applicable teams. Traditionally the league provides hats for the players and Joe asked the membership if they thought this was something the players valued or should be discontinued.
 - g. Teams were reminded to send their team roster, pledge and registration to Pam Hull
 - h. Association registration forms also need to be sent to Pam Hull
 - i. The league will assess a \$50 fine for not handing in the forms by November 1st.

- j. Teams were reminded that there is a \$400 fine for not advising of a game cancellation.
- k. There is a \$50 fine for any jersey found without a Nickel District crest on it.
- l. League Suspensions

Note: All suspensions must be reported to the Convenor

- i. For Bantam/Midget, if the team accumulates 60 minutes in penalties the head coach will be suspended
 - ii. A coach or managers second Gross Misconduct will result in a \$50 fine
 - iii. Fighting the league adds an additional game suspension to the OHF list
 - iv. The league has a 4 penalty rule, which means a player would be suspended upon obtaining his 4th penalty
 - v. 3 GM50 will be a league suspension
 - vi. Second GM56 will result in a league suspension
- m. All re-scheduling forms must be submitted 14 days in advance
 - n. Convenors need to receive the game reports within 1 day
- 8 Hugh Riddle from the NOHA reminded the membership on the following: there is a copy of the suspension list in the NOHA handbook, all teams are required to use the Hockey Canada registry system to register teams with the NOHA, all affiliations need to be declared by October 15th, tournament permit applications must be sent to the NOHA to allow enough time for processing and all exhibition games must be approved by the NOHA council director in that district

- 10 Teams met with the convenors to start scheduling.
